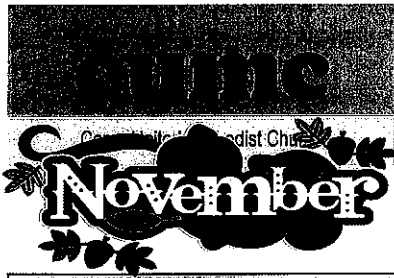

November 2016

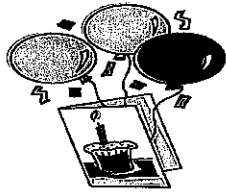

The speaker on Sunday November 13th is Mrs. Wendy Jones, a former runner up in the Miss North Carolina pageant and the founder of a unique ministry for children called "Power Walking". 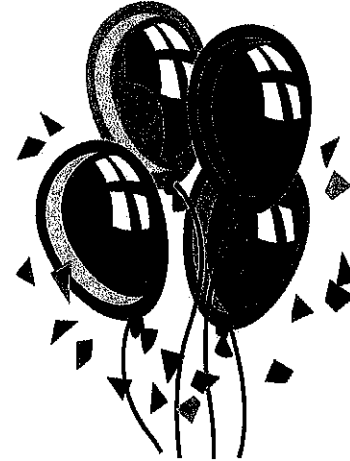

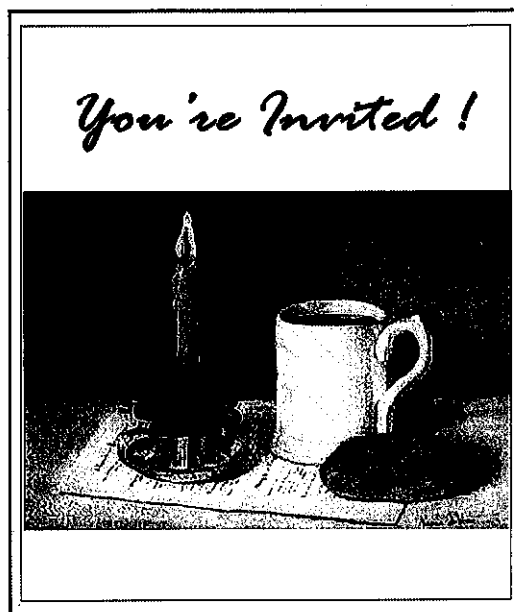

Anthems to be included in the service are as follows: "Morning Star," "Oh, Come, Little Children," "The Child of promise," "Christmas Lullaby," and the Austrian carol, "Still, Still, Still.

This service will involve many Camp members including the Servers, the Methodist Men, the Methodist Women, and the Basket Group. Jane Nichols and Julie Harrelson will coordinate the actual Lovefeast and Wes and Betsy Ward will coordinate the music.

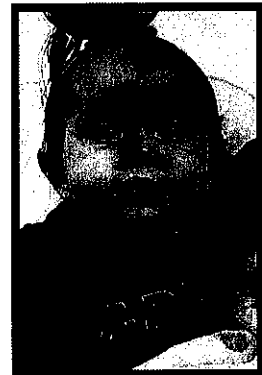
Plan to come and invite the community to this special Advent and Christmas service.

Hero Day

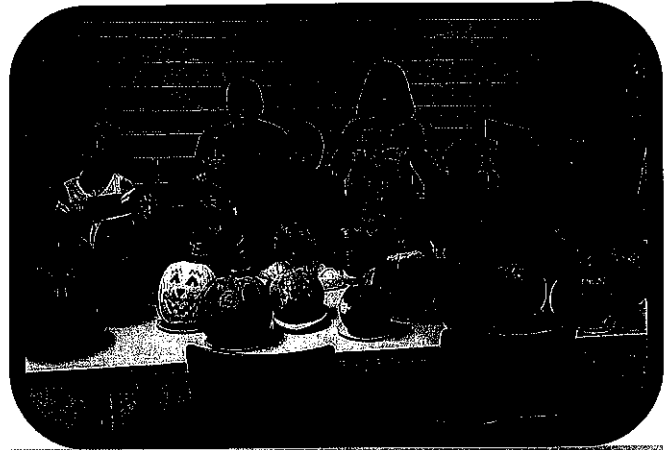
Children dressed as their favorite hero and we made a banner to thank our local heroes. Firefighters and police officers visited the children.

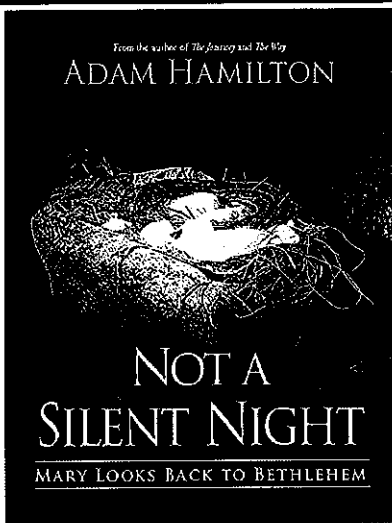

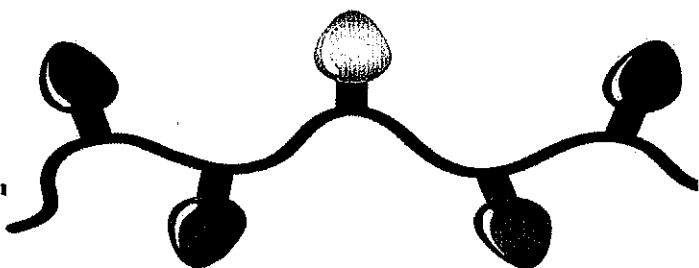


Youth Prayer Breakfast

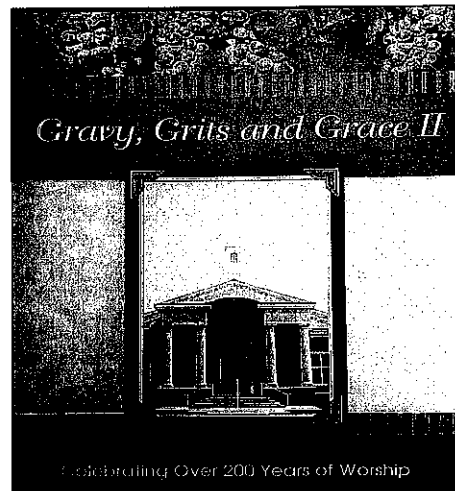

You just have to CARE

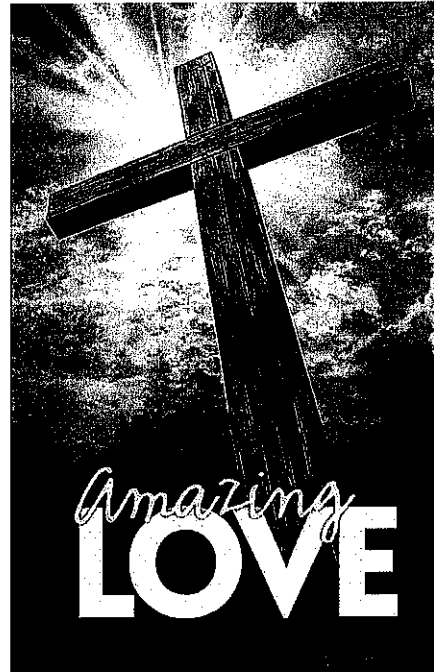
