



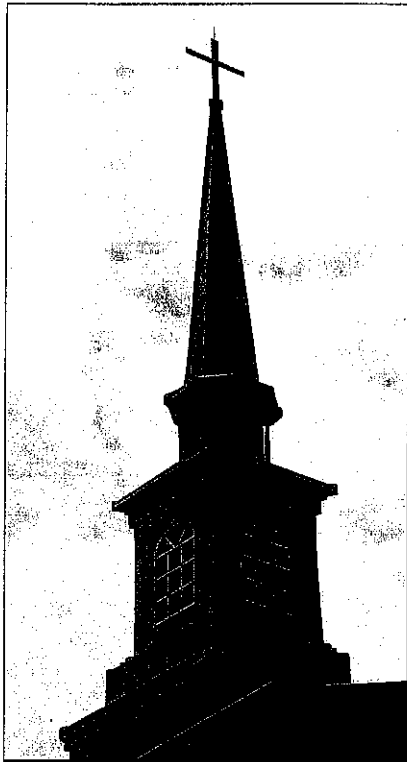

## MONTREAT MUSIC CONFERENCE

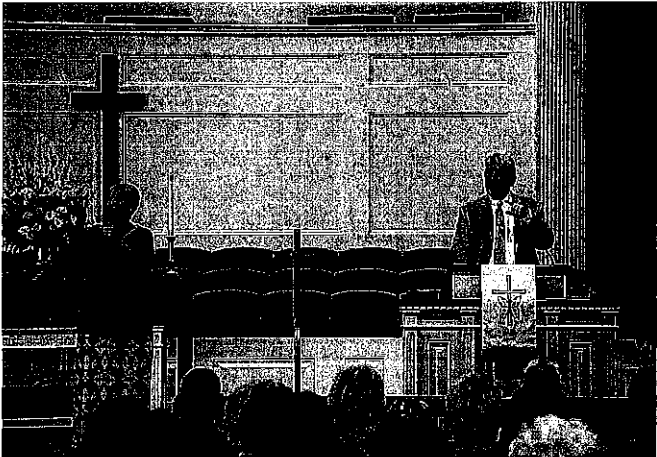
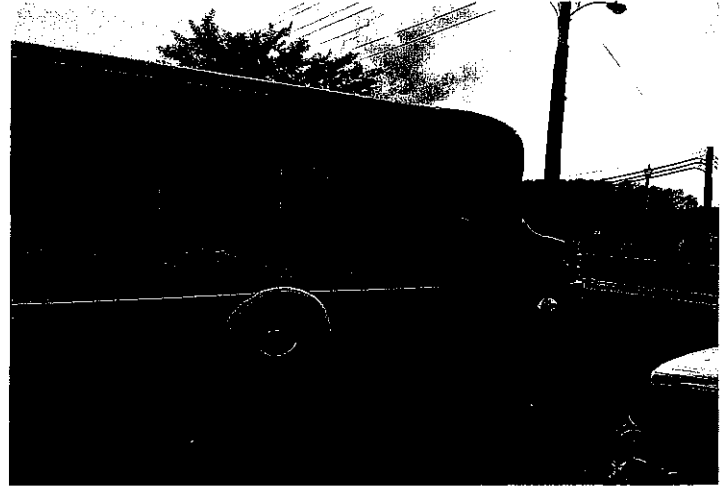

This is due to expenses, both budgeted and unexpected, have been paid. You may have noticed the repairs going on to the old building wing. What started out as minor maintenance to the soffits turned into a much more expensive project than predicted after wood decay was found.

A special thank you goes out to John Donoghue for driving home our beautiful new van all the way from Indiana. The van will be a great addition to our ministry and will be enjoyed by many of our church groups. Thanks to our Camp Youth and Calvin Chandler for leading fundraising efforts which allowed us to purchase the van with money completely separate of our budget in just over 2 years. But most importantly, Thanks to God for this blessing!

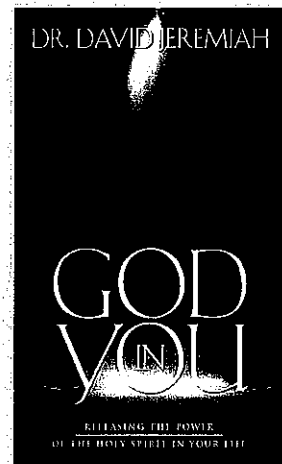
