Your Nurture Team has been working hard to plan this event, but it will truly take all of us to make it a success. The schedule for the day is as follows:

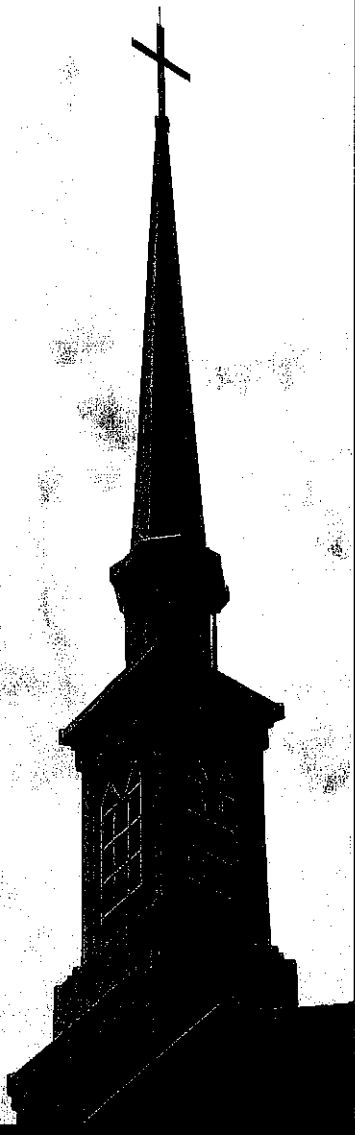
8:45 a.m.	Sunday School
