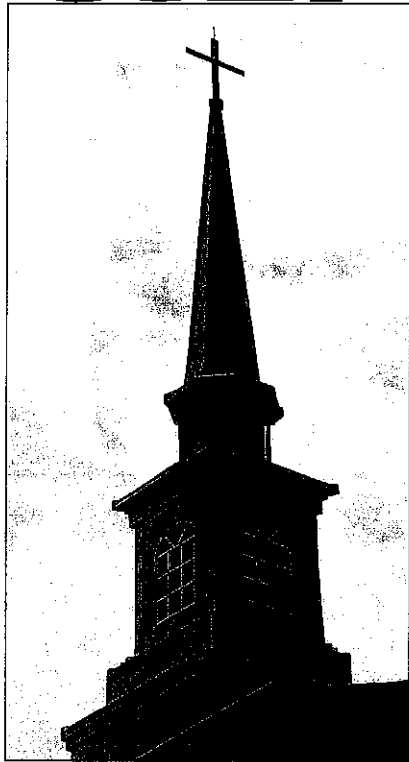
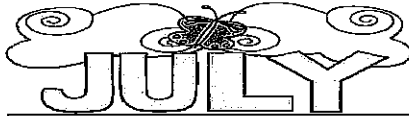

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE 2016 ANNUAL CONFERENCE

1. Annual Conference 2016 set a record for youth attendance!
2. Conference budget passed (2.5 % increase in Conference Insurance)
3. Rev. Leonard Fairley (Capital District Superintendent) endorsed by conference members as episcopal nominee.
4. Bob Bauman steps down as Harbor District DS & Edie Gleaves is appointed as our new DS.
5. The United Methodist Church has raised \$68.5 million for "Imagine No Malaria" and the NC Conference exceeded its \$1 million goal by giving \$1,112,877, saving 111,288 lives!
6. Chaplain Dave Smith spoke about the Soul Care Initiative, resourcing churches to help returning veterans and their families reintegrate into the community. Soul Care wants to help churches help veterans find hospitality and spiritual care to create a climate of healing and care.
7. The minimum salary for full-time pastors for 2017 was approved to increase by 2.8% to a salary of \$43,810 for full-time pastors and \$28,477 for student pastors.
8. 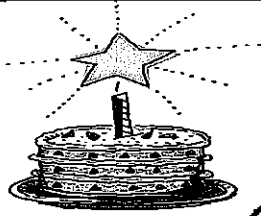

We started off early in the year with a healthy gain of approximately \$28,000 but as you can see, it is decreasing each month. JOSEPH MARTIN CONCERT

Fifteen of our choir members traveled to Laurinburg on June 5th to join eight other choirs to participate in a workshop and worship service conducted by well-known composer, Joseph Martin. Martin is a native of North Carolina and earned his Bachelor of Music degree from Furman University in Greenville, S. C. and his Master of Music degree in Piano Performance at the University of Texas in Austin. A prolific composer of more than 2,000 choral compositions and 53 cantatas, he is a member of the staff of Hal Leonard publications and the editor of sacred publications at Shawnee Press. Joe is Artist in Residence at Concordia University in Austin, Texas, where he lives with his wife, Sue, and children, Jonathan and Aubrey.



Martin gave a very inspiring history of his life by sharing various piano hymns and selections that he had learned throughout his life. Truly, Martin played the piano like no one that we have ever heard before. In fact, one of our choir members remarked that the church in Laurinburg would probably have to call the piano tuner and repair man after Martin's performance! PATRIOTIC MUSIC SERVICE

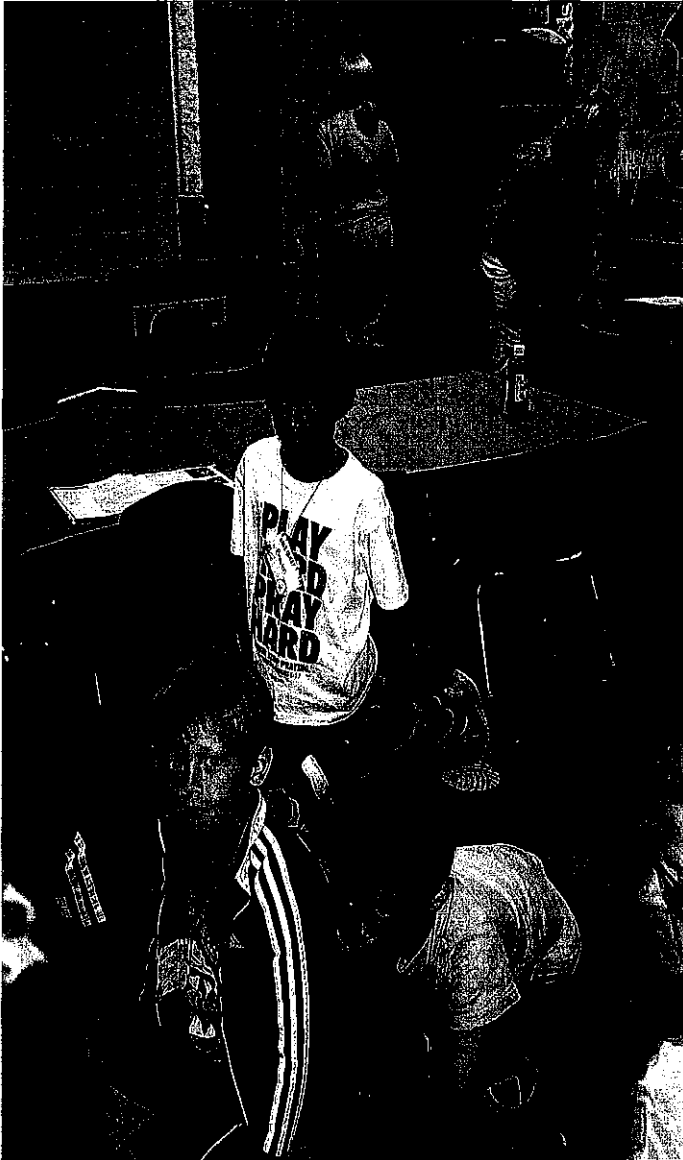

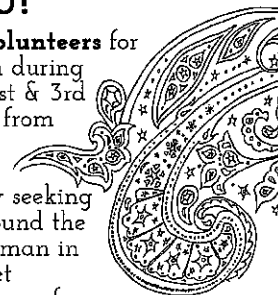
MOPPETS
