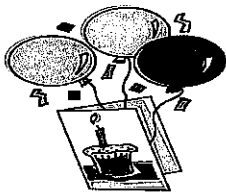

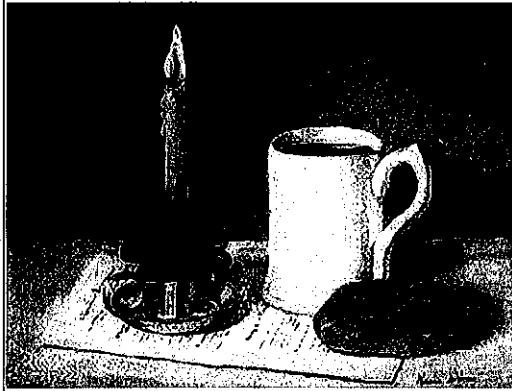

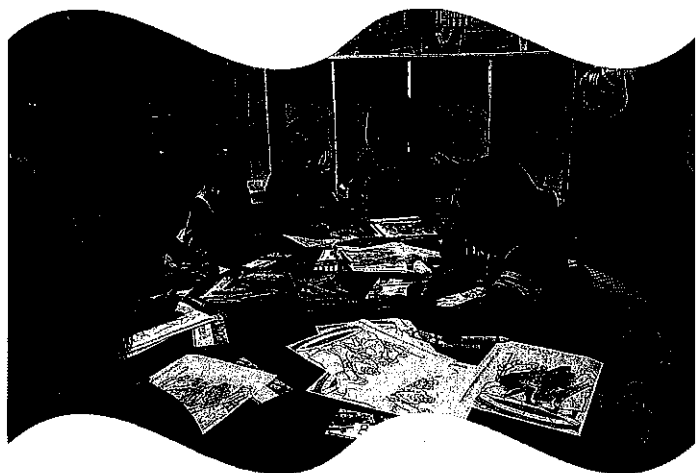
**M** *usic Notes*

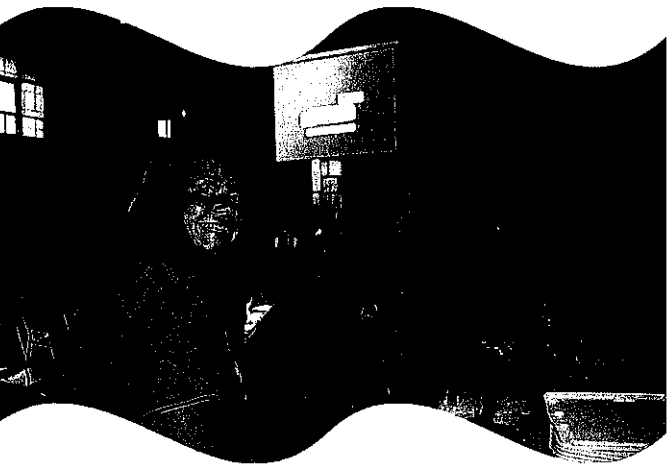

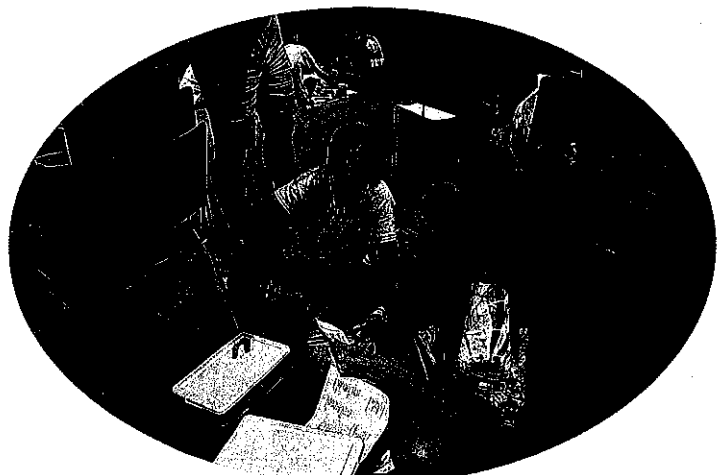

## new MEMBERS CLASS



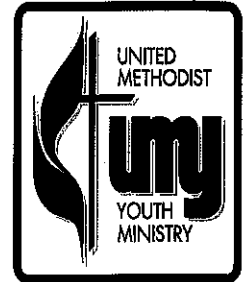
**A new membership class will be starting on October 16, 2016.**

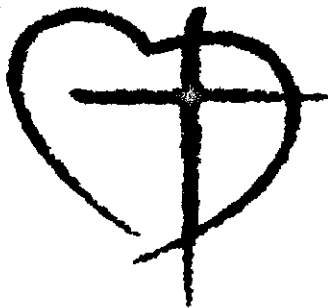

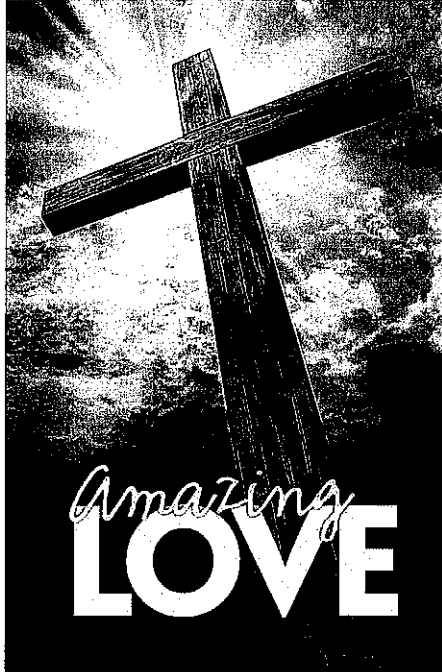
