November 2016

On Sunday, November 6th we will celebrate All Saints Day as we remember and give thanks for our seven precious members who have died in this past year. On November 13th and the 20th, we will be blessed with and give thanks for two very gifted women speakers as we celebrate our United Methodist Women and all they do. The speaker on Sunday November 13th is Mrs. Wendy Jones, a former runner up in the Miss North Carolina pageant and the founder of a unique ministry for children called "Power Walking". She also has a wonderful singing voice that she will be sharing with us on that Sunday. On Sunday November 20th our Harbor District Superintendent, the Rev. Church Mortgage Debt as of 8.31.16: \$1,313,433.00



Children dressed as their favorite hero and we made a banner to thank our local heroes. Firefighters and police officers visited the children.







Not A Silent Night: Mary Looks Back To Bethlehem




Youth Prayer Breakfast

You just have to CARE


